At the animal clinic and shelter in Enumulapalli

We would like to inform you about the kind of support and care we provide for the animals in Puttaparthi and also answer any questions you may have.

There are many misunderstandings about the management and welfare of the stray dog population in this area, what they need, what the law says and what the duties are of an Animal Welfare Organization like Karuna Society.

We will discuss:

- What kind of medical care is available for the animals?
- What is Animal Birth control (ABC) for dogs?
- What is Karuna's legal position?
- How is Karuna being financed?
- Do we work with the government?
- How is the public involved in this?

After a general introduction at the animal clinic, we will show you around and you can meet the permanent residents, dogs, cats cows, horses, donkeys and a camel.

For those who are interested there follows a visit to the wildlife rescue centre, opposite the Super Specialty Hospital, which is normally closed to the public. There are deer, five monkeys, six Sloth bears and four peacocks.
